

Cosplay Contest Rules & Guidelines

Registration Details

- Registration Deadline for Dubai Cosplay Championship: 6 May
- No registration required for Catwalk Cosplay Competition
- Notification: Accepted participants will be notified via email.
- **Character Photo**: Please provide a clear image of the character you will be cosplaying on the registration form.

General Cosplay Rules

- Cosplay must be from published works, such as anime, games, TV shows, movies, manga, live action, etc. Original characters (self-invented or created) are not allowed.
- Costumes and screen content must adhere to the general event rules as well as UAE regulations.
- Costumes should be respectful and culturally appropriate.
- No rainbow symbols or stripes of any kind or form are allowed.
- The body must be covered from the collarbone to at least the lower thigh.
- For men, crossdressing in cosplay is not permitted.
- All materials, including costumes, screen content, skits, and hand gestures, must be PG-13. If you're unsure whether something is acceptable, please contact us.
- Zentai suits (e.g., Spider-Man, Evangelion, etc.) are allowed as long as the suit is PG-appropriate.
- Masks and fursuits are allowed, provided the masks and fursuit heads are easily removable.
- Unsafe props will not be accepted or allowed in the venue or on stage, including metal weapons, sharp objects, firearms, projectiles, and large props that obstruct pathways.
- No sharp, dangerous, or illegal props, including smoke bombs, sharpened metal, swords, ninja stars, or realistic guns without an orange tip.
- You must be able to carry your props and manage them independently.
- Profanity, or anything deemed racially or culturally offensive, will not be allowed.
- Politically charged and/or discriminatory cosplays or props will not be permitted.
- Using any sprays, staining substances, or materials considered damaging to the stage or venue is not allowed.
- The organizer reserves the right to deny entry to any participant whose entry is unsafe, inappropriate, or does not comply with event and UAE regulations.
- All communications will be handled confidentially. Feel free to contact the organizer if you're unsure about your entry.
- All audio-visual content used in performances must be submitted in advance and comply with event regulations.
- Religious and culturally sensitive attire must be respected. Cosplays that mock or misrepresent religious figures, traditional dress, or national symbols will not be permitted.



Catwalk Rules (for all catwalk participants)

- All the above General Cosplay rules must be followed
- Cosplayers must be aged 6+ to enter this competition
- Cosplayers only have 30 seconds on the stage
- Cosplays can be bought or craved, there will be no points allocated towards this aspect

Points will be given on these three aspects:

- Character accuracy in looks
- Character accuracy in act/pose
- Costume quality
- OC cosplays are allowed
- There will be 3 winners
- Sponsor gifts and medals will be given out to the winners
- Prizes will be given out on stage as cosplay winners are being announced
- Only single cosplays and duo cosplays allowed
- COSPLAYERS MUST BE PRESENT BACKSTAGE 30 MINS BEFORE START OF COMPETITION OR THEY
 WILL BE DISQUALIFIED

Competition Rules (for all competition participants)

- All the above General Cosplay rules must be followed
- Cosplayers have a maximum of 2 mins on the stage
- There will be two sections in this competition:
 - o Solo
 - o Group
- For Solo and Group cosplayers must be over 13 years old
- For crafting, there will be prior prejudging, and points will be given on the following aspects:
 - Quality of finished costumes
 - Use of unique materials and techniques
 - Costume accuracy
- **Crafting** will also be judged by stage performance and presence.
- For performance, there will be points given on these aspects:
 - Character accuracy in act
 - Character accuracy in looks
 - Stage presence, audience reaction and 'wow factor' (any special acts that includes singing, aerobics etc. those skills will also be judged if demonstrated by the performer)
 - O NO USE OF FIRE OR SMOKE PROPS ON STAGE



- Act must be PG13 and family friendly (use of indecent imagery such as excess gore or nudity, and use of foul language and controversial topics like politics and religion are strictly forbidden)
- Cosplayers must be present backstage at least 1 hour before cosplay competition. If cosplayers do not show up at least 30 minutes before start time, they will be disqualified.
- O Cosplayers must submit their background video and audio beforehand to the appropriate email/forum. Those videos WILL be pre-evaluated for any use of obscenity.
- There will be three winners in each category.
- O Cash prizes for each category except the kids.
- O Kids will receive a sponsor gift.
- Prizes (including cash) will be given out on stage as winners are announced.

Solo

Max duration of the performance is 1 minute

Groups

- Max duration of the performance is 2 minutes
- Minimum 2 cosplayers, max is 4 cosplayers
- Stage helpers won't be allowed
